We've sponsored a crime tip program for 24 years, and for the last 21 we've been first in PA in money paid out for tips that lead to arrests throughout Berks County.

HOW WE DO IT.

The tipster is given a **code number (the tipster's name is never used)** that corresponds to the crime and the tip, then watches the news media for an arrest in their case. The tipster calls back, gives the code number, and is paid a **reward in cash** for the tip, without anyone ever knowing who he or she is.

WE STARTED 24 YEARS AGO.

Private citizen Barry E. Rohrbach organized an initial board in 1998. We've been the **#1 CRIME STOPPER PROGRAM IN PENNSYLVANIA** in money paid out for tips that lead to arrests for the past 21 years. Rewards are paid in the **event of an arrest, up to \$10,000.**

Crime Alert Berks County is an anonymous, call-in crime tip hot line that provides rewards for crime tips – up to \$10,000.
